

**Travel to and in China, take VU courses, intern in Chinese companies
All in five and half weeks in Summer I of 2011!**

Announcement: 2011 Summer in China Program

Valparaiso University's China Center invites students of all majors to apply for the *2011 Summer in China Program*. The Program offers Valpo undergraduate and graduate students an opportunity to travel to China, take up to six credits, intern in a Chinese institution for five and half weeks during Summer I of 2011 with a subsidy of up to \$800 in lodging and travel. Curriculum: Courses (Participants can take one or both courses)

- **THEO360A/EAST390A**, *Religions of China*, Cr. 3, Professor Pati (Theology)
- **MGT390/ICP690**, *Globalization: Challenges and Promises*, Cr. 3, Prof. Trapp (Business). Course counts as an upper division business elective. Business majors must have junior standing or above to take this course. Non-business majors are welcome.

Internship (* indicates the need for approved by CBA or Graduate School)

- **COMM 386**, *Supervised Internship*, Cr. 3
 - **MGT 395/397/398**, *Internship in Business Administration I, II & III*, Cr. 0.5-2*
 - **ICP686**, *ICP Internship*, Cr.3**
 - **EAST 386**, *Internship in CJS Studies*, Cr. 3

Itinerary: Participants leave from Chicago to Shanghai on May 16 and return from Beijing to Chicago on June 21, 2010. The program includes a four-week (Monday through Friday) full-time internship in a Chinese institution, a two-day weekend trip to Shanghai, a two-day weekend trip to Yellow Mountain, and a three-day trip to Beijing at the end of the program. Other classes are offered in the evenings.

Cost: Valparaiso University summer tuition (based on the number of the credit hours taken with a minimum of 2 credits), international travel (\$1,100 to \$1,300), meals (about \$200-\$350), a \$500 study center fee which covers visa application, international student ID card, and other expenses. **The China Center will cover the costs of all hotel lodging in China, the two-day trip to Shanghai, and the three-day trip to Beijing along with internship-related expenses (local transportation, cell phone, etc.).**

Enrollment: The enrollment is **limited to 20**. **The enrollment is open until all seats are filled.**

Language Requirement: No formal language requirement. However, if you are not a student of Chinese language, you are required to take a non-credit, *Evening Spoken Chinese* class in spring 2011.

Application: To apply, please complete the pre-registration form with the approval from academic advisor. The form can also be downloaded from the announcement section of CJSP's website: <http://www.valpo.edu/chineseandjapanesestudies/>. Dr. Lin, Dr. Pati, and Dr. Trapp will conduct interviews upon receiving the applications. All accepted candidates are required to attend several pre-departure orientation sessions. The formal registration will be completed in April 2010.
