The competition will be followed by an awards ceremony with prizes and a dinner! Students will be grouped and judged according to two levels:

Level I: Students with one or two years of high school Chinese language study will perform short conversational dialogues in groups of two or three on topics relating to everyday life.

Level II: Students with more than two years of high school Chinese language study will deliver individual speeches on the topic: "My Study of Chinese in the US" "我在美国学中文".
