

NCUR 2012 APPLICATION GUIDELINES CHRIST COLLEGE

The Christ College faculty encourages qualified students to present their work at the National Conference on Undergraduate Research (NCUR) at its annual spring conference. This year's conference, March 29-31, 2012, will be held at Weber State University in Odgen, Utah. **To receive financial support from Christ College, you must attend to the following procedure:**

1. Identify a research project you wish to present at NCUR. This may be work completed in any VU course or from an internship or directed research project on- or off-campus.
2. Consult with the supervisor or faculty member who advised the project and secure his or her support as advisor for your application to NCUR.
3. Formally indicate your intention to apply, supplying the preliminary title of your presentation, field of study, and advisor's name in writing to Professor Upton **by October 7, 2011.**
4. Develop a 150-200 word abstract with the help of your advisor. If he or she supports the project but is unable to assist you with the abstract, then secure the assistance of another CC or VU faculty member.
5. Submit your abstract, signed by your advisor, to the Dean's office for review **by November 1, 2011.** This submission indicates your request for funding from CC to cover your travel, lodging, and registration.
6. Submit the on-line application form along with your abstract to NCUR by **November 15, 2011.** A submission to NCUR indicates your commitment to attending the conference regardless of scheduling conflicts that may arise between December and April.

Please note:

Applications must be for paper sessions only (no posters will be funded).

NCUR encourages only one application per student.

All NCUR presenters will also submit their proposals for the VU Celebration of Student Scholarship to be held on April 24, 2012.
