- \$9000 per year (\$36,000 for 4 years)
- Dependent daughters and sons of full-time, professional, rostered Lutheran Church workers. If a student qualifies for a higher academic scholarship, that scholarship replaces the Martin Luther Award. (transfer students also eligible)
