

OTHER VALPO SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps (AFROTC)

- Up to \$15000 for tuition and fees, and a book and monthly stipend
- At Valpo, recipients will also receive enough aid from all sources, to provide at least the standard on-campus room and board costs.

- Renewal: ROTC rules
- Part of the Partner school program with Notre Dame AFROTC program

Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ArmyROTC)

- Up to 100% of tuition and fees, and a book and monthly stipend
- At Valpo, recipients will also receive enough aid from all sources, to provide at least the standard on-campus room and board costs.

National Merit Scholarships

- National Merit Finalists not receiving a corporate scholarship and designating Valpo as first choice. New finalists for 2008 will receive at least \$14,500 in total VU scholarship awards
- Student will be contacted by sponsoring agency for an application
- Will receive notification in Early March by the Office of Financial Aid
- Renewal: Must maintain [Satisfactory Academic Progress](#)

American Mathematical Competition (AMC) Scholarship

- For qualifying undergraduates who have declared a math major
- Must have received above a 100 on the AMC12 their junior year in high school
- \$1,000, non-renewable
