In this program, Valparaiso University students introduce VCS students to the basics of Chinese, French, German, or Spanish as well as elements of culture, in a one-hour-a-week class. Our program is what is known as a "Foreign Language Exploratory" or "Foreign Language Experience" ("FLEX") program. This kind of basic program serves as an introduction to language learning. The classes are held Mondays after school beginning September 2010. There are 8 sessions in the fall and 6 sessions in the spring.
