

EXAMINATION/STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES INFORMATION

There are NO standardized test scores required for students applying to the following programs:

- Master of Science in International Commerce & Policy
- Master of Arts in Liberal Studies (MALS)
- Master of Science in Nursing
- Master of Arts in Community Counseling or Clinical Mental Health Counseling
- Master of Science in Sports Administration

Standardized test scores are REQUIRED for students applying to the following programs:

Master of Business Administration

Master of Engineering Management
The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) exam is required for all students applying to the MEM program. Master of Education – Initial Licensure
The Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST), or Praxis I, in Reading, Writing and Mathematics is required for all students applying to the MEd program. Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
International students must take The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) unless they have received a degree from a US institution of higher education. Passing scores are 530 (paper version) or 213 (computer version). Students may substitute intensive study in English language at the Interlink English Language Center at Valparaiso University. Completion of Level 5 is required. Score of 6.0 or better on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) may also be submitted. <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.
