- GLST 150: Global Perspectives



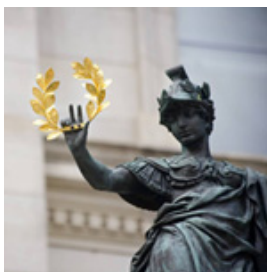
ECONOMICS: 15 credits Students take 5 courses:
