General Information about the Institute

- Registration is limited to five hundred persons. All registrations received by April 1 will be acknowledged and confirmed. No new registrations will be accepted on the day the Institute opens unless we have not received five hundred registrations by that time. Those not pre-registered and confirmed are urged to phone ahead to assure that there is room; phone 219-464-5309.
- There is a reduced rate for additional registrations from a single congregation when a first registration at the regular rate is received and all such registrations are included in the same envelope. Special rates are also offered for those attending for the first time, full-time students, and retired persons.
- Lunches and suppers may be purchased on a cash basis in the new Alan Harre Union Building. Tickets for catered suppers on Monday and Tuesday and for the banquet on Wednesday evening may be purchased ahead of time on the registration form.
