



# Valparaiso University How to Manage your Laundry Online With LaundryView—Student Info Sheet

Information Technology

LaundryView is an Internet application that allows you to monitor the status of washers and dryers in connected laundry rooms through a Web browser. LaundryView is available in Alumni, Brandt, Guild-Memorial, Lankenau, and Scheele halls.

1. On the Valpo network, visit [laundryview.com](http://laundryview.com)  
On the right you can see your residence hall and how many washers and dryers are currently available.

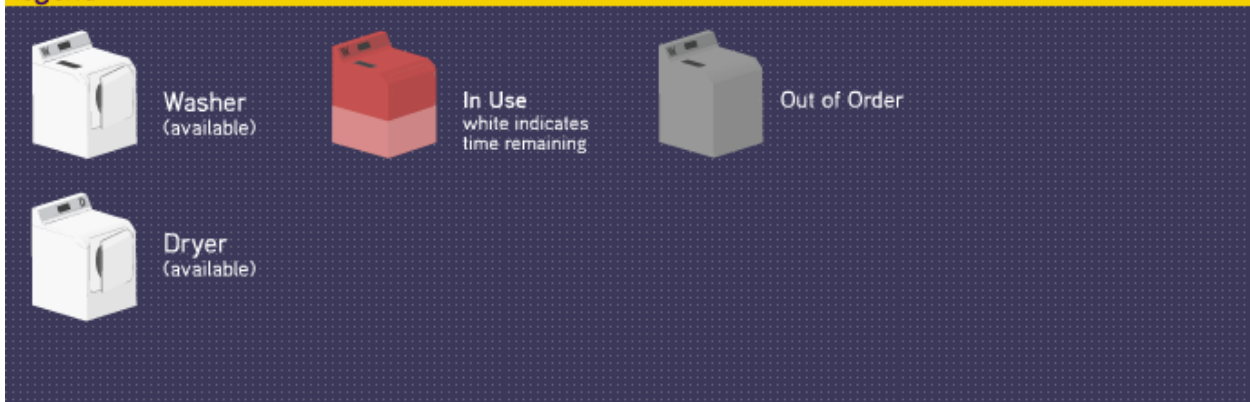


2. Click on your residence hall for a live view of the washers' and dryers' progress. Scrolling over a particular washer or dryer allows you to see if the machine is available, in use, or out of order.



The legend at the bottom of the page shows the different statuses of the machines. If a machine is in use, scrolling over it will allow you to see the time remaining.

LaundryView can also send you text alerts to let you know your washer or dryer has finished its cycle. Standard text messaging rates apply.
