



Conference Overview

As the foreclosure crisis deepens, Indiana homeowners are in greater need of assistance from trained housing counselors and attorneys. “Defending Foreclosures, Saving Homes” speakers have extensive experience in predatory lending and foreclosure litigation, workouts, and bankruptcy. Viewers of the conference DVD, filmed March 28, 2008, will learn about the latest developments in foreclosure and bankruptcy, loss mitigation and mortgage servicer practices. Attorneys interested in representing homeowners will learn the nuts and bolts of the Indiana foreclosure process, explore effective claims and defenses available to homeowners, and learn how to present workout and loan modification proposals to mortgage servicers. Housing counselors will learn more about judicial foreclosure in Indiana and options available to homeowners at each stage of the process. Architects of the Indiana Foreclosure Prevention Network also explain the IFPN initiatives—including the recently established hotline and referral network.
