2L Requirements for Academic Year 2008-2009

Evidence (Honors) (3 crs., Law 210-HA, letter grade, fall)

In the second year, third semester students in the Honors Program will be required to complete the honors section of Evidence.

This course is a study of the federal rules of evidence. An assigned textbook supplies the background to prepare for class discussion of the rationale supporting the evidence rules. Class discussion includes application of evidence rules in context.

2L or 3L Requirement

Externship/Clinic Requirement

Following completion of all 1L required courses, Honors Program students must successfully complete an externship or a clinic for a minimum of three credit hours. Please note that Clinics prefer that you register for two (2) semesters and require an interview at the Clinic in advance of registration.

3L Requirements for Academic Year 2008-2009

All third year Honors Program students are required to take the designated 3L Honors Seminar. Law Review students are NOT exempt from this requirement.

Grade Point Average Requirement

Honors Program students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0, measured at the end of each academic year. Summer course work is excluded in determining whether the GPA requirement is satisfied.
