### Applicant Boot Camp (ABC)

ASPIRE ABC module is an intensive experience designed to have students ready to apply upon completion. Participants will receive support and guidance for completing their AMCAS applications and preparing to interview. Each aspect of applying is addressed—from clarifying a student's motivation for medicine to strategies for choosing which schools to apply. Guidance in professionalism and personal development is also offered.

### Health Equity & Advocacy Leaders (HEAL)

The HEAL modules introduce students to health disparities and strategies to achieve greater health equity. These modules are Stritch mission focused and aim to help participants understand the need to increase justice in health and the responsibilities of physicians as advocates and change agents.
