## Director, Virtual Learning Center

To accommodate growth, the College of Nursing and Health Professions (CONHP) at Valparaiso University invites applications for the Director of their Virtual Learning Center. The non-tenure track position is announced at the assistant professor level, but outstanding candidates could be considered at a higher rank with multiple years of teaching experience, an established research agenda, and scholarly accomplishments.

Valparaiso University is a distinguished private university of 4,500 students located in Valparaiso, IN, one hour southeast of downtown Chicago. Candidates should be interested in working at a university engaged in issues in Christian higher education in the Lutheran tradition. The College of Nursing and Health Professions has programs in nursing (BSN, MSN, and DNP), health care leadership (BSHCL), health administration (MHA), public health (BSPH and MPH), and physician assistant studies (BSHS and MPA).

Responsibilities include working cooperatively with the dean, faculty, staff, and students to provide a conducive learning environment for undergraduate and graduate students; develop simulation scenarios in conjunction with faculty; coordinate the purchase, maintenance and management of equipment and supplies. The successful candidate will hold an earned MSN degree (doctoral preferred). The preferred candidate will have three or more years of clinical experience.

To apply, submit a letter of application, curriculum vitae, summary of clinical experience, undergraduate and graduate transcripts, and three letters of recommendation.
