The Department of English at Valparaiso University seeks a visiting assistant professor with expertise in professional and technical writing and/or writing in the health sciences. Teaching will include some combination of courses in general education in humanities, technical and business communication, writing in the health sciences, and advanced composition.

Position from August 2017 to May 2018. Ph.D or ABD required. Candidates should be interested in working at a university engaged in issues in Christian higher education in the Lutheran tradition, which emphasizes excellent teaching and commitment to student learning, and is increasing its international enrollment and programming. In addition to strong academic qualifications and excellence in teaching, the University highly values experience in working across cultural and other significant differences. Successful applicants will demonstrate a commitment to cultural diversity and the ability to work with individuals or groups from diverse backgrounds. Teaching load will likely include three courses per semester and could include upper-division, graduate, and general education courses.
