Visiting Assistant Professor of Health Care Leadership (HCL)

To accommodate growth, the College of Nursing and Health Professions (CONHP) at Valparaiso University invites applications for a Visiting Assistant Professor of Health Care Leadership. The position is announced at the assistant professor level, but outstanding candidates could be considered at a higher rank with multiple years of teaching experience, an established research agenda, and scholarly accomplishments.

Valparaiso University is a distinguished private university of 4,500 students located in Valparaiso, IN, one hour southeast of downtown Chicago. Candidates should be interested in working at a university engaged in issues in Christian higher education in the Lutheran tradition. The College of Nursing and Health Professions has programs in nursing (BSN, MSN, and DNP), health care leadership (BSHCL), health administration (MHA), public health (BSPH and MPH), and physician assistant studies (BSHS and MPA).

This position is a full time, 9 month appointment, beginning August 2015. Responsibilities include teaching expertise in HCL undergraduate courses; mentoring students; working collaboratively with faculty within the CONHP and the university; providing service to the university, profession, and the practice community of HCL; and developing a research and scholarly agenda in the field. The successful candidate will hold an earned doctorate in health care administration, health services, health policy, or a closely related field. The preferred candidate will have three or more years of experience working in a health care environment; demonstrated excellence in teaching; and a strong record of research and scholarly accomplishments.

To apply, submit a letter of application, curriculum vitae, undergraduate and graduate transcripts, and three letters of recommendation. In addition, submit a statement of teaching philosophy that indicates teaching experience and pedagogical approaches.
