Visiting Faculty Position in Transportation Engineering

The Department of Civil Engineering at Valparaiso University invites applications for a visiting faculty position for the 2017-2018 academic year, beginning August 2017. Primary teaching responsibilities will include two discipline-specific courses: Introduction to Transportation Engineering and Design of Transportation Facilities. Other teaching responsibilities may include introductory civil engineering courses, civil engineering capstone design courses, general engineering courses and transportation electives courses. Preference will be given to applicants with an earned Ph.D. in civil engineering or a closely aligned field, but consideration will be given to applicants with an earned Master's degree. The successful candidate will possess enthusiasm for undergraduate teaching and the ability to interact and effectively communicate with students and faculty from diverse backgrounds.

Located an hour from Chicago in northwest Indiana, Valparaiso University (www.valpo.edu) is a comprehensive university with about 4,500 students. Valparaiso University's undergraduate-only civil engineering program offers an ABET-accredited BS Civil Engineering degree and currently enrolls approximately 120 students across all classes.
