

SCHEDULING OF FINAL EXAMS FOR 75 MINUTE CLASSES

We frequently receive questions regarding how the 75-minute classes fit into the final examination schedule template found on page 4 of the Spring Schedule of Classes which only lists the beginning time for 50-minute periods.

Because of the potential for overlapping times and therefore room conflicts, we have developed the following guidelines for 75-minute classes to ensure that two classes will not be meeting in the same room at the same time for final examinations.

Use the time period that corresponds to when most of your class period occurs.

Do not use the ending time of your class or the period which covers most of your class time, since in some cases there are potential conflicts.

This will work for 75-minute classes that are offered on either day sequence, Tuesday-Thursday or some combination of Monday-Wednesday-Friday.

For example, using information from page 4 of the Spring Semester Schedule of Classes, the following final exam times would be assigned:

TR 8:15-9:30	8:00	8:00-10:00	Sat., May 8
TR 9:45-11:00	10:10	10:30-12:30	Tues., May 11
TR 11:50-1:05	11:50	10:30-12:30	Fri., May 7
TR 1:20-2:35	2:00	1:00-3:00	Mon., May 10
TR 2:50-4:05	3:05	3:30-5:30	Sat., May 8
