

Welcome to Dining Services. Your buy-in level of participation in the declining meal plan is contingent on your residence and the number of semesters you have completed in your college career (see below). Only mandatory meal plans are reflected on your pre-bill from financial aid. You will be billed officially after you register for meal plan.

Meal plan registration will take place in the West Hall of the Student Union on Monday, January 7, 2008 through Tuesday, January 8, 2008 and then in the meal plan office in Jesters of the Student Union beginning Wednesday, January 9, 2008. You **must register with Dining Services directly**, before your money will be posted on your account.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

ROLLOVER: a maximum of \$75.00 will be rolled over to your spring account (only) after you buy-in for your minimum mandatory meal plan.

TRAINING TABLE: This is an optional addition to your declining balance meal plan. It offers four dinner meals Monday through Thursday at Wehrenberg cafeteria which provide larger entrees with unlimited side dishes and salad bar choices. The additional cost per semester at the a'la Carte minimum mandatory buy-in level or higher is \$520.00. A student may add this option with a clerk at meal plan registration.
