ing with your RLC. Applications will be due on October 30th at 5:00 p.m. There will be an interview process from November 2-4. Qualifications for applying to become and RA are:

- have a current GPA of 2.3
- Be in good standing with the University
- Have 24 credit hours before

Spring 2010

- Have lived on campus for one semester at time of employment
