- Craft and develop practical leadership skills through the planning, promotion and implementation of various programs and projects. These could include informational, orientation and re-entry sessions for students planning to attend or return from study abroad programs, international dinners, presentations by local experts that accentuate the appreciation of the history, culture and contributions for their country of choice, and much, much more!
- Request an international roommate and live in close proximity to students from a wide variety of cultural backgrounds.
