Clarian Health Partners, Inc.'s Summer Student Research Program, funded by the Methodist Research Institute- Indianapolis, IN

-This internship is for science and medical students interested in medical research. They are to design and perform a biomedical experiment, analyze the data, prepare a written and oral report, and know how to prepare a manuscript for submission to a peer-reviewed journal. These internships require 40 hours per week.

-Applicants in undergraduate programs must have at least 60 credit hours and be enrolled full-time. They must also have a GPA of at least 3.0/4.0.

Indiana University Cancer Center Summer Research Program- Indianapolis, IN

-The purpose of this program is to increase the number of students from under-represented populations pursuing careers in biomedical and behavioral sciences.

-High school and undergraduate students are eligible.

Indiana University School of Medicine's James Simmons Summer Internship-

Indianapolis, IN

-There are two of these internships available each summer, and students are accepted first come, first served. These are flexible, and students may observe clinical work or assist in clinical research projects.

-Undergraduates are eligible, but an interest in child psychiatry, psychiatry, psychology, or pediatrics is preferred.

-There is no formal application.

-There is no deadline. The first two qualified applicants are accepted.

-The salary is about \$500 per month, but housing is not provided.

-The internship time frame is flexible, but lasts roughly three months.

Indiana School of Medicine Undergraduate Summer Biomedical Research Program- Indianapolis, IN

-This internship program brings students into the labs of medical school faculty.

-Applicants must have at least 2 years of coursework in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Engineering. Preference is given to those with 3 years of coursework and those with a strong interest in M.D./Ph.D. programs or careers in academic medicine.

Indiana University Summer Research Experiences for Undergraduates in Biomedical Sciences- Evansville, IN

- The research topics include membrane biology, cell biology, neuroscience, and immunology.
- Undergraduates who have shown an interest and aptitude for basic scientific inquiry are eligible.

- This internship has a \$2500 stipend. University housing is available.

Johns Hopkins University Summer Internship Program (SIP)- Baltimore, MD

- This is a research internship in biomedicine and public health.
- Students who have completed two or more years of college and are from underrepresented minority groups or economically disadvantaged and under-served backgrounds are eligible.

- The internship has a \$3000 stipend, and housing and a shuttle service are provided.
- This internship lasts 9-10 weeks.

Northwest Center of Indiana University School of Medicine's Summer Research Program- Gary, IN

- This internship involves biomedical/basic research, and a final oral presentation of the work upon its completion. Also, students may be invited to present at national meetings or to publish in scientific literature.
- Open to interested and motivated students.

University of Iowa Carver College of Medicine Summer Research Opportunities Program in Pharmacology- Iowa City, Iowa

-The objective of this program is to provide hands-on experience to undergraduate students interested in biological sciences. Mentoring, informal research discussions, and weekly research talks are given. At the end of the program, each student presents their work to the department in a 10-15 minute talk.

-Eight to twelve students are hosted.

Applicants need also turn in a transcript, two letters of recommendation, and a letter of intent. This letter needs to include a ranking of the department labs that the applicant is interested in, specify the type of research of interest, how participation will help achieve a personal or career goals (which should be listed), and any prior research experience.
