

S.R. 85 – Letter to CCPC concerning Parking Garage Safety

First reading on 11/02/2009

- WHEREAS the students of Valparaiso University have raised safety concerns about the U-turns in the Northeast Parking Garage; and,
- WHEREAS if this safety concern is not sufficiently addressed it could cause bodily and monetary injury to students of Valparaiso University; and,
- WHEREAS under the Internal Governance documents of Valparaiso University, the Campus Community Policy Committee (CCPC) is charged with making recommendations on “campus planning and development, and physical plant programs and priorities” to the University Council; and,
- WHEREAS it is the duty of the Student Senate of Valparaiso University to address concerns of its constituents, therefore be it
- RESOLVED that the Student Senate approve the appended letter to be signed and sent to the Chair of the Campus Community Policy Committee (CCPC) to address the safety concerns raised by students regarding the Northeast Parking Garage.
