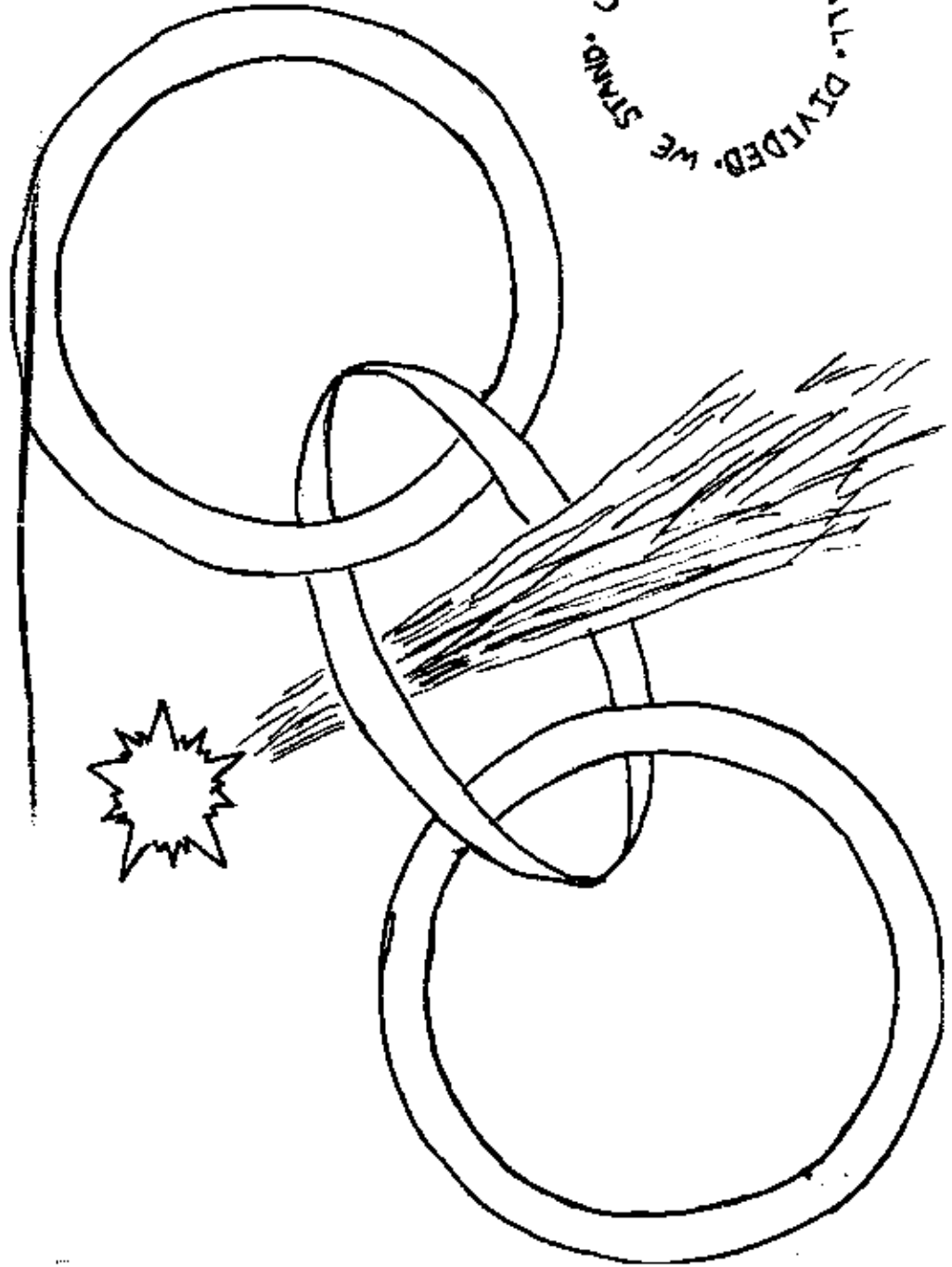

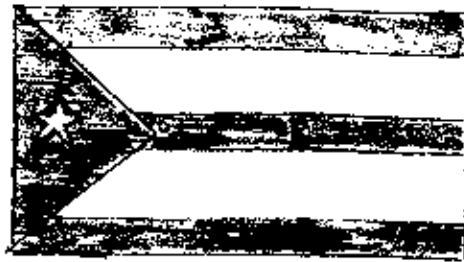

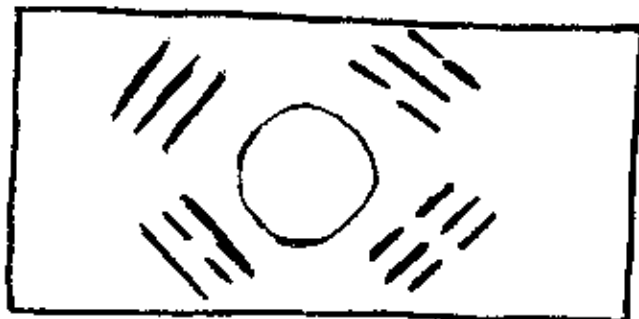

Appreciation is what you need

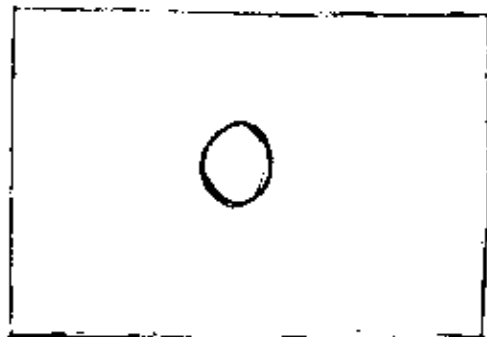

I WON'T KEEP YOUR FAITH ALIVE!

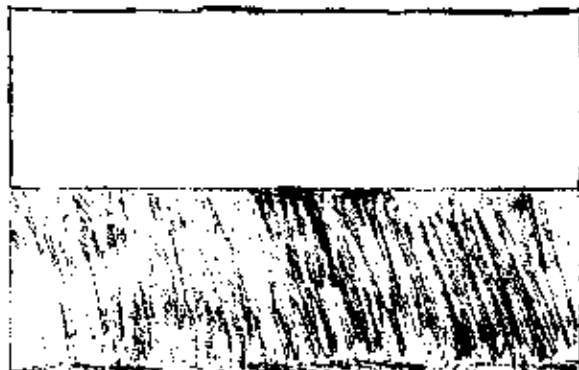
What do you mean we bombed your home?

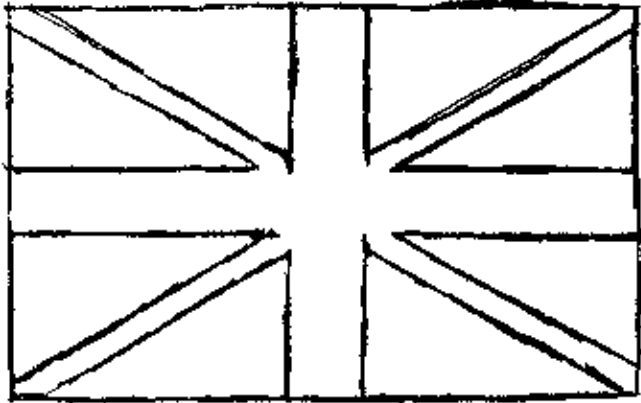
Look at what we're doing here!

It's a young dream just begun

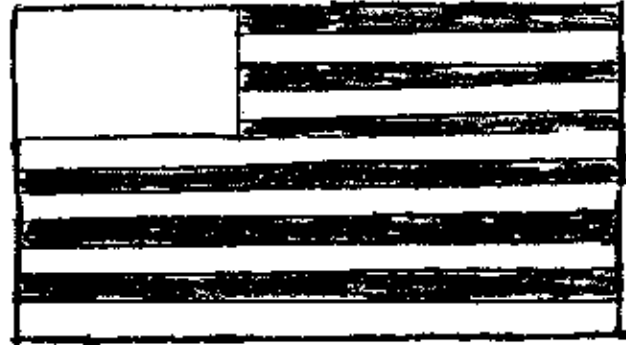
