

TO WHAT DEGREE MUST WE ALL CONFORM SO THAT COMMUNITIES CAN RUN SMOOTHLY, AND, CONVERSELY, HOW MUCH SACRIFICE MUST COMMUNITIES BE WILLING TO MAKE SO THAT THE IDENTITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL IS NOT QUASHED? IN THEIR SEARCH FOR AN ANSWER, THE CHARACTERS STRUGGLE TO DECIDE WHO IS CAPABLE OF CALLING SOMEONE INSANE, OR EVEN IF INSANITY CAN BE CONSIDERED TOTALLY BAD. THIS AMOUNTS TO AN ARISTOTELIAN QUEST FOR THE GOLDEN MEAN BETWEEN TOO MUCH RESTRICTION AND TOO MUCH FREEDOM.

**A**MONG THE CHARACTERS IN SPRUNG ARE NARCOLEPTIC TWINS WHO TRADE CONSCIOUSNESS, A SPLIT PERSONALITY PIRATE/NINJA, AND AN ALTOGETHER LOVABLE BUT COMPLETELY NON-EXISTENT ELEPHANT NAMED ANTONIO.
