
Turn your paper test into a Blackboard Test!

There are many different types of test questions available on Blackboard such as quiz bowl, hotspot, fill-in-the-blank, matching, and the newest type called hot spots!

Carol Goss, LRC Director, recently booked a Blackboard test training session to turn her paper exam into a Blackboard exam. She was thrilled about the hotspots. Hotspot questions present students with an image that requires them to drop a pin on one or more hotspots created by you. See the example below.
