Don't miss your chance to have a voice in making that decision.

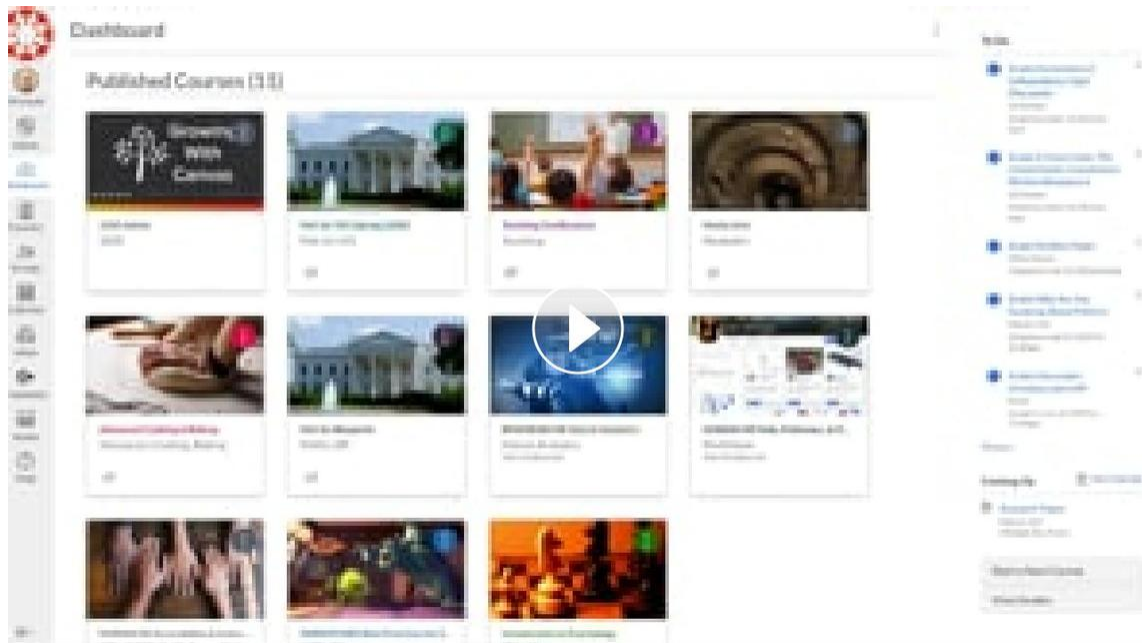
