Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship	The Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship provides 200 high-achieving high school and college students interested in pursuing a career in education the opportunity to earn a renewable scholarship of up to \$7,500 a year for four academic years. In exchange, students agree to teach for five years at an eligible Indiana school or <i>repay</i> the corresponding, prorated amount of the scholarship.	www.in.gov/che/4680.htm
William A. Crawford Minority Teacher Scholarship	The William A. Crawford Minority Teacher Scholarship is available to minority students who intend to pursue, or are currently pursuing, a course of study that would enable them to teach in an accredited school in Indiana. Students must agree in writing to apply for teaching positions in Indiana and, if hired, teach in Indiana for at least three years.	www.in.gov/che/4507.htm
Student Teaching Stipend for High-Needs Fields	The Student Teaching Stipend for High-Need Fields is available for students who plan to teach in a high-need field (defined as middle or high school level math, science or special education). Students are eligible to receive the stipend in the term they are student teaching as a part of their degree requirements. Students must agree in writing to apply for teaching positions in Indiana and, if hired, teach in Indiana for at least three years.	www.in.gov/che/4510.htm
Earline S. Rogers Student Teaching Stipend for Minorities	The Earline S. Rogers Teaching Stipend for Minorities is available for minority students who will participate in student teaching or a school administration internship as a part of their degree requirements during the semester in which they receive it. Students must agree in writing to apply for teaching positions in Indiana and, if hired, teach in Indiana for at least three years.	www.in.gov/che/4511.htm

Federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness	The PSLF Program forgives the remaining balance on your Direct Loans after you have made 120 qualifying monthly payments under a qualifying repayment plan while working full-time for a qualifying employer.	studentaid.ed.gov/sa/repay-loans/forgiveness-cancellation/public-service#what-is-the-public
Teacher Loan Cancellation	Federal Perkins Loan cancellation is based on eligible employment or eligible volunteer service and the length of time that you were in such a position. Discharge of your Perkins Loan may occur under certain circumstances.	studentaid.ed.gov/sa/repay-loans/forgiveness-cancellation/perkins#teacher-eligibility
Teacher Loan Forgiveness	Under the Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program, if you teach full-time for five complete and consecutive academic years in a low-income school or educational service agency, and meet other qualifications, you may be eligible for forgiveness of up to \$17,500 on your Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans and your Subsidized and Unsubsidized Federal Stafford Loans.	studentaid.ed.gov/sa/repay-loans/forgiveness-cancellation/teacher
TEACH Grant	The TEACH Grant Program provides grants of up to \$4,000 a year to students who are completing or plan to complete course work needed to begin a career in teaching.	studentaid.ed.gov/sa/types/grants-scholarships/teach
