On January 23, 2017, Sigma Lambda Gamma officially became the Delta Zeta chapter of SLG. President Karina Calvillo said "becoming the Delta Zeta chapter of Sigma Lambda Gamma National Sorority, Inc. has been one of the greatest accomplishments for me as a student. Two years ago we were just a group of women sitting around the student affairs suite talking about what we wanted and if the fraternity and sorority community would be welcoming to the traditions and ways of a multicultural sorority." Valparaiso University's 2016 Panhellenic and Interfraternity Councils were honored this year at the Association of Fraternal Leadership and Values (AFLV) Conference in Indianapolis, Indiana. The Panhellenic Council received awards of distinction in all eight potential categories and won the Sutherland Award for Overall Excellence for the fourth year in a row! Additionally, the Panhellenic Council received the Kaleidoscope Award and Gamma Phi Beta Panhellenic Campus Impact award for the Faces of Mental Health initiative that took place in October 2016.
