Two members of Phi Kappa Psi and one member of Sigma Phi Epsilon have been recognized for excellence in NCAA athletics.

- Jeremy Getz ($\Phi K \Psi$) holds the 2013 Horizon League title for the Javelin throw in Track & Field
- Eric Honert (ΣΦΕ) set a new all-time Valpo Men's Tennis Singles Record in September 2013
- Thomas Wettstein (ΦKΨ) earned recognition at the Horizon League Individual Championship in Golf

All three men were named to the Horizon League Academic Honor Roll for both the fall and the spring semesters. Additionally, Getz and Wettstein qualified for their respective NCAA Championship tournaments, with Getz setting the NCAA record in Javelin. The Gamma Phi Beta, Zeta Iota chapter at Valparaiso University has spent the last few weeks heavily involved with their two philanthropies, Girls on the Run and Campfire USA. Both entities are non-profit organizations that aim to build strong youth for a brighter future.

On November 2, 2013, Gamma Phi Beta held their annual "Gamma Phive K", to support Girls on the Run. With close to 100% participation from the other fraternity and sorority chapters at Valpo, the proceeds from the "Gamma Phive K" are going to help build a new chapter of Girls on the Run in West Lafayette. Many of the Gamma Phi Beta sisters are also involved with the non-profit as coaches for the LaPorte County chapter of Girls on the Run.

Also this fall, Gamma Phi Beta members from Valpo packed up their camping gear and headed to Camp Tannadoonah in Vandalia, Michigan in support of Campfire USA. Sisters cleaned the campgrounds for the winter and helped prepare the grounds for the upcoming summer. This is a weekend that is particularly special for the Zeta Iota chapter members as the women get to directly see how their donations are helping and who they are impacting.
