# Valparaiso University's 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Dance Marathon Raises More Than \$24,000

The Valparaiso University fraternity and sorority community hosted the second annual Dance Marathon benefitting Children's Miracle Network Hospitals. Dance Marathon is the official philanthropy for the fraternity and sorority community, however the event is open to all students and organizations on campus. More than 400 students from 19 on-campus organizations danced for eight hours on Saturday, February 1, 2014 in support of the kids receiving treatment at the Ann and Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago.

The Dance Marathon "Miracle Kids," who are children that have been patients at CMN Hospitals, shared some touching personal experiences that were impactful for all participants. Over the course of the fundraising period, participants raised \$24,286.59, far exceeding last year's total of \$10,417.07. The 2014 "Miracle Cup" was given to the organization that collectively raised the most funds, and this year the cup went to Chi Omega for raising \$5,040.00!!
