## ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE CONTINUES FOR VALPARAISO UNIVERSITY FRATERNITIES AND SORORITIES

The spring 2014 Fraternity and Sorority Academic Report indicates that the All-Sorority and All-Fraternity Grade Point Averages are once again higher than the All-Female and All-Male averages at Valparaiso University. The 328 sorority women recorded a 3.291 average semester GPA which is above the 3.196 average semester GPA of women at Valpo, and the 352 fraternity men recorded a 3.117 average semester GPA which is above the 2.983 average semester GPA of the men at Valpo. In addition 11 out of 13 chapters performed above a 3.0 chapter GPA and more than 40% of sorority women achieved above a 3.5 semester GPA for the spring semester.


