Both the Jellison Award and the Sutherland Award are awarded to a single school in each institutional size category based on their documented programs and activities that align with national best practices. Both Valparaiso University councils were recognized for excellence in all eight possible categories, which is why it is an incredible honor for both the IFC and the Panhellenic Councils to bring these awards back home to Valpo.

Participating in the AFLV Central Leadership Conference is an incredible experience that shows the importance of fraternity and sorority life as delegations from across the country were in attendance. All proceeds will be donated to the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation. This foundation is very important to Sigma Lambda Gamma because the chapter shares a strong value for women empowerment and being a support for any woman that needs it.

In hosting the chapters third annual Penny Wars, the chapter raised a record-breaking amount of \$1,017. This is the largest amount the women of Sigma Lambda Gamma have raised in all three years of putting on this event.

Valpo Fraternities and Sororities Excel Academically in Fall 2017

The Fall 2017 Fraternity and Sorority Academic Report indicates that the All-Sorority and All-Fraternity Grade Point Averages are once again higher than the All-Female and All-Male averages at Valparaiso University. The sorority women recorded a 3.367 average semester GPA, and the fraternity men recorded a 3.182 average semester GPA. In addition, 13 out of 15 chapters performed above a 3.0 chapter GPA and more than 42% of sorority women and fraternity men achieved above a 3.5 semester GPA for the spring semester.
