Application Process

- Reference form submitted by a
 VU faculty or staff member
- 2. Online Application
 - a. Personal statement
 - b. Resume
- 3. Official transcript
- 4. Advisory committee interview



Application Timeline

- Nov 14: Application Opens
- Jan 17: Application Closes
- ▶ **Feb 1:** Semi-Finalist Notification
- ▶ **Feb 11:** Interviews of Semi-Finalists
- ▶ Feb 17: Finalist Notification
- ► Mar 20-24: Placement Interviews
- ► April 3: Placements Offered



Application + Interview Tips

- ► Start early!
 - Give appropriate time for references + essay writing
- Utilize career center + writing center
- Practice giving your personal "elevator pitch"
- Come prepared with questions
- Dress professionally
