

Student Location Policy

For the purposes of the US Code of Federal Regulations, specifically 34 CFR 600.9, 34 CFR 668.14, 34 CFR 668.43, a student enrolled at Valparaiso University is located in the state of Indiana if any of the following conditions are true:

1. The student is living in campus housing offered through the Office of Residential Life. This includes admitted students with an active housing application on file for their first term of enrollment.
2. The student is enrolled in an academic program in which on-campus coursework is required.
3. The student has a local address in the Ellucian Colleague student information system that is in the state of Indiana.

If none of the statements above are true, the student's location will be determined by the local state or territory listed in the local address field in the Ellucian Colleague student information system. If no local address exists in the Ellucian Colleague student information system, the home state or territory in the home address field in Ellucian Colleague will be used to determine a student's location.

For the purposes of these regulations, initial enrollment is defined as the first day of the first term in which a student is enrolled in a program.
