

If you have a car, two ways to get there from Valparaiso University *

* Go east on US 30 to US 421. Turn right (south) on 421 and go approximately 4 miles until you get to CR 1600 S. Turn right (west) and go 1.6 miles. Their house is on the left, a tan brick ranch style and there are several white sheds.

* Go south on State Road 49 to CR 300 S. (Morgan Twp School). Turn left (east) and go approximately 4.5 miles to CR 650 E. Turn right (south) and go 1 mile to CR 400 S. Turn left (east) and go 1 more mile. Their place is on the right (south) side of the road. (They are a half mile into LaPorte County, therefore the road number changes when you cross the county line.) Their house is a tan brick ranch style and there are several white sheds.
