Generic and unsolicited - The email may say your information was

Impersonation of a Valparaiso University community member or **company** - Sometimes scammers impersonate faculty, deans, or other community members to trick students into giving up personal information. Many times the email is from a Gmail, Yahoo, or Outlook address (not_ valpo.edu!). Legitimate companies should email from their corporate email

Too good to be true - Job offer scams entice with unbelievably good

account. They ask for personal information in an email - Legitimate job opportunities require you to apply and provide your personal information in an official application, most of the time via the company website.
