

Generic and unsolicited - The email may say your information was obtained from a job board, school database, or the Career Center. If that were true, they should have been able to address the email to you directly,

Too good to be true - Job offer scams entice with unbelievably good pay for very easy work—something that just isn't that common in the real

Impersonation of a Valparaiso University community member or **company** - Sometimes scammers impersonate faculty, deans, or other community members to trick students into giving up personal information. Many times the email is from a Gmail, Yahoo, or Outlook address (not_

In the past few weeks the Valpo IT department has received several


inquiries about potential job-related
