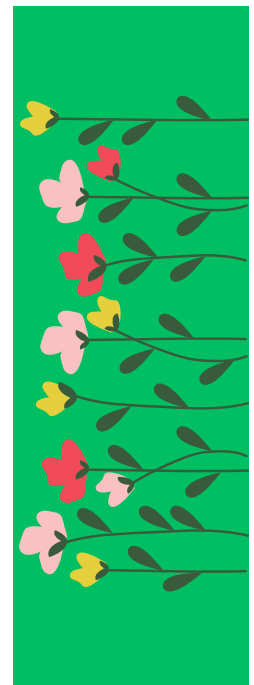
Upgrades in Gellersen

Upgrades to Gellersen Classrooms

Over spring break the IT staff were able to complete some upgrades to eight different classrooms in Gellersen Hall.

The following classrooms have been given new AV switchgear: 159, 162, 225, 227, 229, 231.

Additionally, rooms 120 and 224 were given new Zoom lecture capture functionalities as well as high definition PTZ cameras and 360 degree ceiling array microphones.

These upgrades should allow for smoother use of technology in the classrooms and add additional opportunities for quality recordings of lectures in those spaces.
