

Accusative Prepositions

There are 7 common accusative prepositions:

- durch = through
- für = for
- gegen = against
- ohne = without
- um = around/about
- bis = until/to
- entlang = along

In a prepositional phrase with an accusative preposition, the noun following is always automatically in the accusative case.

Entlang is different:

Entlang will follow the noun, instead of the noun following it.

How to remember the accusative endings?

Use the 2nd line of the chart:

➔ R E S E
N E S E
M R M Nⁿ
S^s R S^s R
