

## Genitive Prepositions

There are 9 common genitive prepositions:

- während = during / at the time of
- trotz = despite / in spite of
- (an)statt = instead of
- wegen = because of
- innerhalb = within / in the space of
- außerhalb = outside / beyond
- jenseits = beyond / on the other side of
- diesseits = this side of
- unweit = not far from

In a prepositional phrase with a genitive preposition, the noun following is always automatically in the genitive case.

The “an” on anstatt is optional

How to remember the genitive endings?

Use the 4<sup>th</sup> line of the chart:

R E S E  
N E S E  
M R M N<sup>n</sup>  
➔ S<sup>s</sup> R S<sup>s</sup> R

How to remember the genitive prepositions?

The most common are the first 4 on the list; there is no real way to remember these other than direct memorization.
