Prepositions that take the accusative case

<i>Ante</i>	Before
<i>Ad</i>	To, toward
<i>Circum</i>	Around
<i>Contra</i>	Against
<i>Inter</i>	Between
<i>Intra</i>	Within
<i>Post</i>	After, behind
<i>In</i>	Into, onto
<i>Praeter</i>	Beyond, except for
<i>Per</i>	Through, because of, thanks to
<i>Propter</i>	On account of
<i>Super</i>	Above
<i>Versus</i>	Against
<i>Extra</i>	Outside of
<i>Trans</i>	Across
<i>Sub</i>	Under (with verbs expressing motion)
<i>Ob</i>	On account of

Prepositions that take the ablative case

<i>A (Ab)</i>	From, by
<i>De</i>	Down from, concerning, on
<i>Cum</i>	With
<i>E (Ex)</i>	Out of, away from
<i>In</i>	In, on
<i>Sine</i>	Without
<i>Pro</i>	For, on behalf of
<i>Prae</i>	Before, in front of
<i>Sub</i>	Under
<i>Super</i>	Above (with verbs expressing rest)

Be careful! These prepositions may take either the accusative or the ablative: *In, sub*

Prepositions that take the ablative case

<i>A (Ab)</i>	From, by
<i>De</i>	Down from, concerning, on
<i>Cum</i>	With
<i>E (Ex)</i>	Out of, away from
<i>In</i>	In, on
<i>Sine</i>	Without
<i>Pro</i>	For, on behalf of
<i>Prae</i>	Before, in front of
<i>Sub</i>	Under
<i>Super</i>	Above (with verbs expressing rest)

Be careful! These prepositions may take either the accusative or the ablative: *In, sub*
