



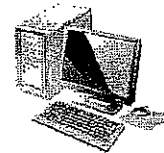
Free & Reduced Prescriptions

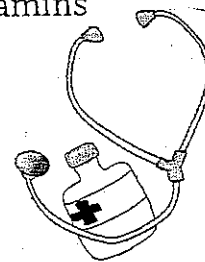

FREE PRESCRIPTIONS at Meijers

The following RX are FREE with your doctor's prescription, regardless of insurance. Prescriptions must be picked up at Meijers in person with identification.

- ♦ Amoxicillin ♦ Ampicillin ♦ SMZ-TMP ♦ Maternity Vitamins
- ♦ Cephalexin ♦ Lipitor ♦ Ciprofloxacin
- ♦ Penicillin VK (Maximum 14 day supply of normal oral dosages)
- ♦ Metformin (up to 100 tablets per fill with refills free of charge)
