### MATH 299: Mathematics Colloquium II

<b>Description:</b>	<i>Students are required to attend sessions of MATH 499, evaluate student presentations, and continue participating in co-curricular mathematical activities culminating in MATH 399.</i>
<b>Credit Hours:</b>	0 (Graded S/U)
<b>Frequency:</b>	Offered every semester.
<b>Audience:</b>	Required for mathematics majors in the sequence MATH 199, 299, 399, 499.
<b>Prerequisites:</b>	MATH 199.
<b>Format:</b>	One 50-minute seminar per week.
<b>Textbook:</b>	None.
<b>Internet:</b>	Course material and grades are often maintained in Blackboard, at the discretion of the instructor.
