

# Move-In Instructions

---

## All Areas Except Lankenau, Alumni, and Brandt Halls

1. Check your Valpo e-mail for your **move-in appointment time** from Residential Life

The beginning of your arrival window gives you a little bit of time to move-in before returning students start coming back. Take advantage of that if you can!

2. Enter campus from the Sturdy Rd or Highway 30 entrance (south side of campus) and **follow the flow of traffic to your residence area.**

Some campus roads that are normally 2-way streets will be 1-way for move-in day.

3. Park wherever you can near your building and **Mask Up!** Face masks are required indoors at all times and outdoors when you cannot be more than 6 feet away from others.

4. **Check in with Residential Life staff** at the front desk of your building.

5. **Unload your vehicle** and take your belongings inside.

- a. As soon as your belongings are inside, please move your vehicle to the nearest residential parking area (blue lot) to create space for the next person to unload.
- b. A limited number of moving carts will be provided by Residential Life but you may wish to bring your own hand cart if you don't want to wait for one.

6. Continue following COVID-19 Precautions: wash/sanitize your hands frequently; distance from others as best you can; and keep your face mask on throughout move-in day!

If you have questions or need something in the hall, look for one of the Residential Assistants (**RA**) – student staff – or Residential Learning Coordinators (**RLC**) – professional staff- at the front desk of your building or on your floor.
