

# Getting to VALPARAISO UNIVERSITY

## The quick and easy guide for getting to and from campus

Valparaiso University is approximately an hour from downtown Chicago, so getting to and from campus can be easy! Follow this guide to help understand the ins and outs of getting to the region's major transportation hubs and the vibrant surrounding area of Porter County.

### MIDWAY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

**Distance from Campus:** 57 miles  
**Airport Code:** MDW  
**Airlines Serviced:** Allegiant Air, Delta, Porter, Southwest Airlines, Volaris



### GETTING THERE

- One-hour drive by car
- ChicaGO Dash Bus - Downtown Valparaiso > Orange Line Train
- South Shore Train to Millennium Stop > Orange Line to Midway

### SOUTH SHORE TRAIN

**Distance from Campus:** 14 miles  
**Route:** Downtown Chicago Millennium Station to South Bend, IN Airport  
**Local Stop:** Dune Park — Chesterton, IN



### GETTING THERE

- 20-minute drive by car
- South Shore Connect Express (Valpo V-Line) Bus stop located on the north side of campus at University & LaPorte Ave.

### O'HARE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

**Distance from Campus:** 74 miles  
**Airport Code:** ORD  
**Airlines Serviced:** Most major international airline carriers



### GETTING THERE

- 1.5-hour drive by car
- ChicaGO Dash Bus — Downtown Valparaiso > Blue Line Train
- South Shore Line Train to Millennium Stop > Blue Line to O'Hare



## VALPO V-LINE TRANSIT SYSTEM

The V-Line Transit Bus system is **FREE** for Valparaiso University students with valid student ID and has four routes with stops at locations including the South Shore Line, Valparaiso University, major local shopping centers, and downtown Valparaiso.
