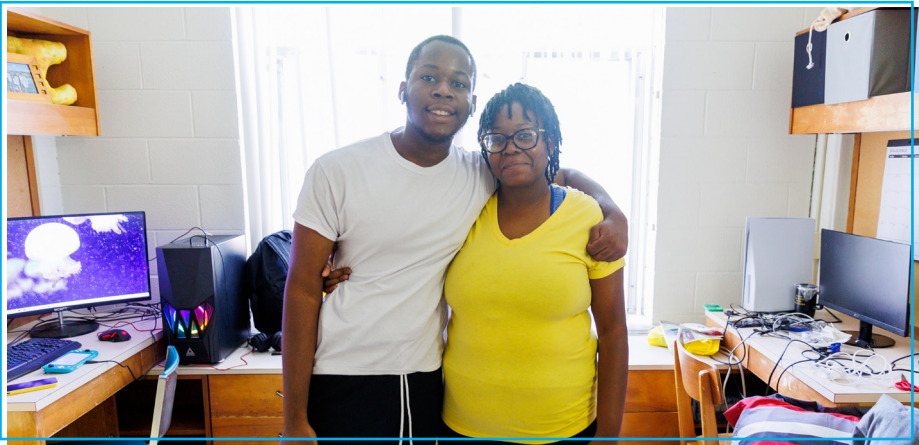
Dance Ensemble Auditions
